

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION FOR THE ORANGE SPORTS CHALLENGE 2025

1. Participation and process

The participation at the ORANGE Sports Challenge (OSC) of Hoffmann Group is solely conform by these conditions of participation.

Only Hoffmann Group and SFS Group employees may participate and register an account on this website.

Hoffmann Group reserves the right to stop or change the ORANGE Sports Challenge without prior notice and expressed reason or regarding the organization or other special conditions.

With participation in the ORANGE Sports Challenge, the participant is explicitly accepting the conditions of participation.

2. Participation period, tasks, prizes

The ORANGE Sports Challenge runs from 12 May to 6 June 2025. Participation takes place by registering on the portal and entering the minutes of sport completed during this period. Participation in the ORANGE Sports Challenge is free.

Registration takes place directly on the ORANGE Sports Challenge website. After logging in, you can enter the minutes of sport you have done in the system. In principle, any sport that is practiced at home or outdoors counts, e.g. workout, yoga, cycling, jogging, tennis, etc. A sport that does not involve physical activity, such as chess or e-sports, cannot be entered. We trust that all participants enter their sports minutes conscientiously and do not record their break times as sports minutes.

Entries can be made up to a maximum of 14 days after practicing the sport and no later than Friday, 6 June 2025 at 11:59 pm. All entries made later will expire and will no longer be considered. The portal will then be closed to determine the winners. No entries can be made at a later date.
