1. What is the OSC?

OSC stands for ORANGE Sports Challenge and is used as an abbreviation during this campaign. Employees of all Hoffmann Group subsidiaries and of SFS Group worldwide are called upon to collect as many sports minutes as possible during the campaign period from 12 May to 6 June 2025 and to enter them in the portal provided for this purpose. The more minutes of sport we do, the higher the donation to the Hoffmann Group Foundation will be.

2. Which sport can I do?

Generally, all types of sports are allowed. Sporty ambition is important no matter if the sport is done indoors or outdoors. We count e.g. hiking, running, soccer, workout, yoga, etc. The type of sport also needs to be declared in the portal when entering the minutes.

Please do not enter sports minutes for sports like chess or e-sports, as there is no physical action involved.

The total number of employees at your location is also considered. The winning location receives a challenge cup, which can be defended the following year.
